Sustain and Develop Long-term Partnership

The collaboration will run again in July 2024 involving MAALCC and MUIC plus two extra courses: Ma Animation online and MA 3D.

The collaboration facilitated cultural exchange and networking, with an AR graffiti piece in London and Bangkok, ensuring long-term impact. Methods included a blog, industry feedback, and social media engagement for impact assessment.

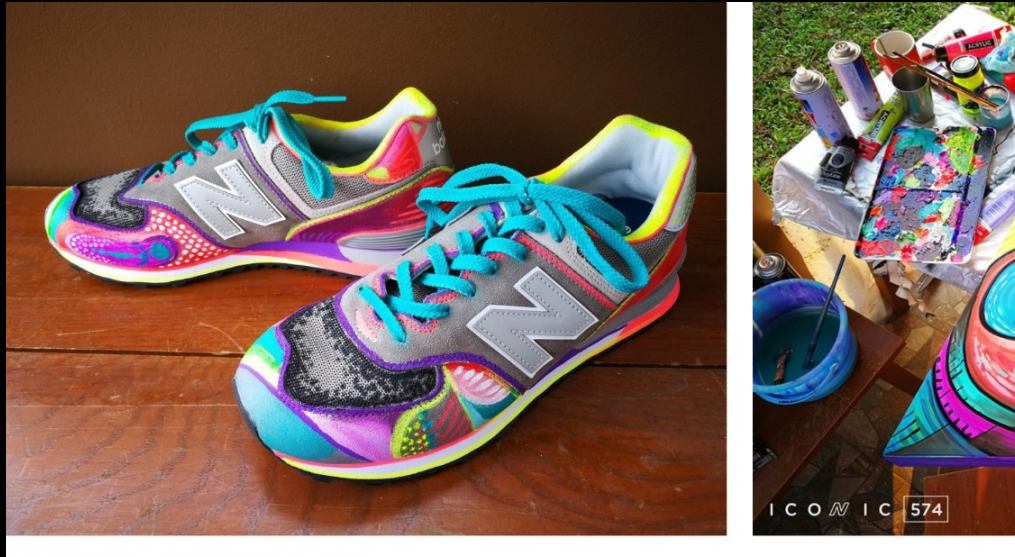

Methods Employed to Measure Impact

Impact assessment methods included:

- Blog Documentation: Participants' progress, reflections, and collaboration were qualitatively assessed through a group blog. [ANICODEX 2022-23 Padlet.pdf](#)
- Feedback from Industry Professionals: External evaluation by industry experts provided insights into project quality and relevance.
- Social Media Engagement: Dissemination of clips on platforms like Instagram and Vimeo enhanced outreach and potential societal impact.
